First week of August FLUSHING HYDRANTS: The Town will be flushing hydrants the first week in August from the 1st to the 5th. The flushing will start at 8:00a.m. and continue throughout the day. After flushing, your water may be red and dirty for a time. In order to clear your water, let your cold water tap run for several minutes until clear water is restored. You may want to make preparations to have water on hand prior to this week.

August 13th from 5p.m to 7p.m, a Saturday at Svilar Park: The Hudson Baptist Church will host a Back-to-School cookout for all of Hudson's Children. There will be hot dogs and hamburgers, cold drinks and treats, along with door prizes, games, and other fun activities.

METER READ PAD AND/OR METER PIT's: Please continue to make efforts to ensure safety for our meter reader by keeping the area clear of debris, animals, and easily assessable for reading efforts. It is generally around the 20th of each month that meters are read.

WHEN YOU HAVE A CONCERN ABOUT SOMETHING IN TOWN: We encourage you to come into the Town Hall and file a written complaint, so that it is on record. You may also go online at www.hudsonwyoming.org and grab a victim/witness statement form from the FORM tab. This enables us to look at the Ordinances, and take the proper steps to remedy the issue; which may include conflict resolution with support from the Sheriff's office.

Brush Pile: You will need to come to the Town Hall, sign a log book and check out a key in order to get into the pile.

CEMETARY: Construction on the fence will begin soon. The town is still accepting donations of steel posts, woven wire, or barbed wire for this project, please contact the Town Hall at 332-3605.

LIVESTOCK: Livestock permits are required annually for all livestock. This includes chickens, ducks, geese, horses, etc. You may get forms on the town website at www.hudsonwyoming.org or, a permit form may be obtained at the Hudson Town Hall.

Attention Pet Owners – Reminder for your annual PET LICENSE end date of May 31, 2017: Please be sure to come to the Hall and get a pet license, if you have not already done so. Remember, all dogs and cats need to have a tag number associated to them. The cost is \$7.50, unless spayed or neutered, the cost is reduced to \$5.00.
