TOWN OF HUDSON MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS FOR SALE: Dog pen. Sealed bids must be received by the Town of Hudson, 333 South Main Street, or P.O. Box 56, Hudson, WY 82515, no later than 5p.m. Tuesday February 23rd 2016. The bid must be in writing, giving the bidder's name, address and telephone number, and bid amount. The sealed bid must be clearly marked "Misc. Item Bid" on the outside of the envelope. Bids will be opened Thursday, February 25th, 2016. The Town of Hudson will accept the high bid. Payment must be made in cash, money order, or cashier's check, and item collected within seven days of notification to the high bidder; or it will go to the next highest bid.
