Hudson Post Office: A message from the Post Master. Please be advised. In order to ensure timely and accurate delivery of your mail, please be sure to use your PO Box number as your correct address, as we have no physical address delivery.

If you are receiving a package and they will not accept a PO Box, either list your PO Box on the second address line option, along with your physical address, or use the Zip Code Plus Four feature (i.e. If your PO Box number is #56, then you would use 82515-0056). Thank you!

HUDSON FIRE DEPARTMENT: A huge thank you to the Hudson Fire Department for hosting the Labor Day Community Picnic. Also, the Fire Department want to remind you, that Fire Prevention week is October 9th through 15th. Please check your smoke alarms to ensure they are in working condition, and replace batteries. If you have any questions or concerns on fire safety, please contact the Fire Department at 332-3264.

- Smoke alarms should be replaced every 10 years.
- Make sure you know how old all the smoke alarms are in your home.
- To find out how old a smoke alarm is, look at the date of manufacture on the back of the alarm; the alarm should be replaced 10 years from that date.

Please come and check out Hudsons Closet (Same hours as the Town Hall): We have a lot of clean, cute, helpful clothing items, dishes, bedding, towels, etc. Take items that you know others could use, or if, you find something useful for yourself. Items are free of charge. We have quite a supply on hand of clothing, baby clothing, diapers, etc., along with some coats in all sizes. Do come in and check out what we have on hand, as the Closet also serves as a means of exchange to assist each other. Our goal is for “peace of mind”, and a sense of community.

To DONATE: Items need to be free from stain/rips, in working condition, and small supplies-items that contain all of their pieces and parts. In order to manage Hudson's Closet, when you

donate, we do need you to please help us keep the Closet organized, by assisting with placement of items when possible. **The Methodist Thrift Shop has graciously donated gift certificates. For more information or to volunteer, please inquire at the Hall office.**

Free bread is typically delivered to the Town Hall on Wednesday afternoons, around 3p.m. This is a service provided by the Hudson Baptist Church, so be sure to thank Craig Waters, when you see him around.

METER READ PAD AND/OR METER PIT's: It is generally around the 20th of each month that meters are read. Please continue to check your meter, and confirm that it is safe to access for our reader. With incumbent cold weather, please make sure area is free from ice, snow, high weeds, and/or materials piled on, or around them.

WHEN YOU HAVE A CONCERN ABOUT SOMETHING IN TOWN: We encourage you to come into the Town Hall and file a written complaint, so that it is on record. You may also go online at www.hudsonwyoming.org and grab a victim/witness statement form from the FORM tab. This enables us to look at the Ordinances, and take the proper steps to remedy the issue; which may include conflict resolution with support from the Sheriff's office.
