**METER READ PAD AND/OR METER PIT’s:** It is generally around the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month that meters are read. Please continue to check your meter, and confirm that it is safe to access for our reader.

**WHEN YOU HAVE A CONCERN ABOUT SOMETHING IN TOWN:** We encourage you to come into the Town Hall and file a written complaint, so that it is on record. You may also go online at [www.hudsonwyoming.org](http://www.hudsonwyoming.org) and grab a victim/witness statement form from the FORM tab. This enables us to look at the Ordinances, and take the proper steps to remedy the issue; which may include conflict resolution with support from the Sherriff’s office.

**NUISANCE, DOGS AT LARGE, & VICIOUS DOGS:** The Governing Body, and office have received complaints about dogs that have been vicious, lunging at others, are running at large, and bark excessively.

Any person who owns more than three dogs, must get a **KENNEL PERMIT** on a yearly basis. It is also important to **have your dog licensed, yearly**, by May 31<sup>st</sup>. Forms may be picked up at the Hall, or you may get one online at [www.hudsonwyoming.org](http://www.hudsonwyoming.org) They are reviewed and approved by the Mayor and Town Council.

In the Town Code of the Town of Hudson are the following definitions of nuisance & vicious dogs. "Noisy dog" means any dog which habitually, constantly or frequently disturbs the sleep, peace or quiet of any neighborhood." "Nuisance" means any animal which trespasses on public or private property; is at large, damages, soils, defiles or defecates on private or public property other than that of its owner; habitually, constantly or frequently disturbs the peace of any neighborhood or person; chases pedestrians, bicyclists or motor vehicles; attacks other domestic animals, or any noisy or vicious dog." "Vicious and dangerous dogs" – No person shall own, keep or harbor, or allow to be upon any premises occupied by him or under his charge or control, any vicious dog, without having such dog properly secured and muzzled."

"Owner – means any person owning, keeping or harboring a dog cat or another animal. Any person who shall permit an animal to habitually remain or to be fed in or about his premises shall be considered and be held to be the owner of such animal."

"Restraint" An animal is under restraint within the meaning of this chapter if it is within the property limits of its owner or keeper or under actual physical control of said owner or keeper.

**BRUSH PILE:** You will need to come to the Town Hall, sign a log book and check out a key in order to get into the pile.

**CEMETARY:** Construction on the fence is slated to begin soon. The town is still accepting donations for the construction materials to accomplish this project.
