There are to be no fence posts, lumber, building demo, personal garbage, cans, metal or plastic, etc. placed in the pile. **Flood Mitigation:** Efforts continue. May 6th, ANNUAL ANIMAL LICENSING/VACCINATION CLINIC: The clinic will be held on **Saturday, May 6st from 9:00 to 12 Noon at the Hudson Town Hall.** As per Ordinance #811 – Section 4-15 **all dogs and cats** must be registered on a yearly basis. License tags for non-neutered animals are \$7.00/year and \$5.00/year for neutered animals. **To license your animal, a proof of current rabies certificate is required.** Dr. Richard Boulette of Wind River Veterinary Clinic will be completing needed vaccinations.

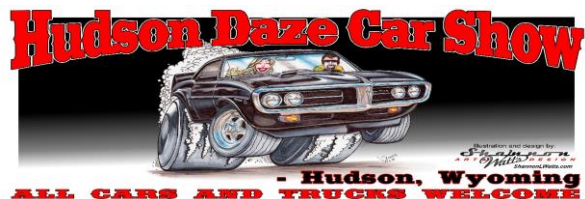

PREPARING FOR MOSQUITO SEASON: A reminder to look at anything that you own outside, that can hold water. To **reduce mosquito** risks around your home:

- Look for standing water in and around your backyard.
- Drain or treat standing water.
- Use an aerosol or propane fogger to clear mosquito's
- Treat shady areas around the house, especially around entry ways where resting mosquitoes are more likely to come indoors.

This is a reminder that we are set up to do offer **monthly AUTO PAY online**, through XpressBillPay.com.
