**INVITATION TO BID:** Notice is hereby given that the Town of Hudson, will receive sealed bids for the Indiana Avenue Paving Project at the Hudson Town Hall, 333 South Main Street, P.O. Box 56, Hudson, Wyoming 82515, until 2:00 p.m. (local time), on September 7, 2017, at which time and place said bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. The improvement shall consist of, but not be limited to, the following major construction items: *Placement of crushed base aggregate and 3 inches of asphalt paving on approximately 4 blocks (1,400 feet) of Indiana Avenue.* Each bid must be accompanied by Bid Security, made payable to the Town of Hudson for five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid. Bid security may be in the form of a certified check, bank check or a Bid Bond. Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids. These documents are available only in digital format for a non-refundable fee of \$10.00. On-line registration is mandatory for all bidders. You may also go online at [www.hudsonwyoming.org](http://www.hudsonwyoming.org) and grab a victim/witness statement form from the FORM tab. This enables us to look at the Ordinances, and take the proper steps to remedy the issue; which may include conflict resolution with support from the Sheriff's office.

**Mosquito's:** Spraying continues. Although very minimal in numbers, the **West Nile virus** was recently found in the area. Please continue to protect yourself from mosquito risks around your home, and while outside.

**Hudson Library:** The Library will be closed the week of September 4<sup>th</sup>.
