**Noise Ordinance:** Please remember our Town does have a noise and disturbing the peace ordinance regarding barking dogs, recreational and vehicle noises, etc. We ask that you please consider your fellow neighbors and immediately take care of barking dogs, in addition to not disturbing the sleep of others.

**METER READ PAD AND/OR METER PIT along with WINTER WATER ALLOWANCE 3,000 GALLONS:** We still our having cold weather. Please be aware, that pipes are freezing. Be sure you turn on a trickle of cold water, and keep it running to prevent your lines from freezing. An allowance of an additional 3,000 gallons on your water bill is permitted now. Here is how to read the volume/usage for the month on your bill. In the description area of the bill. You will see a section that says, Meter Readings. The information then spells out your previous reading, your current reading and how much water was used. EXAMPLE: Previous 2552 Current 2562 Usage 10000. Please continue to check your meter, and confirm that it is safe to access for our reader. With the cold weather, please make sure the area is free from ice, snow, or materials piled on, or around them.

**Library Notes from Julie:** GOOD NEWS! Our little library is now ready to be a part of our Wyoming library system! Bring your Wyoming Library card with you when you come to check out materials. If you don't have one, I can issue you one. (We will issue only one card per household.)
