Resolution # **2018-01** Adopting **the Region 5 WY Mitigation Plan**

Whereas, the Town of Hudson/Fremont County, recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (“Disaster Mitigation Act”) emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards;

Whereas, the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local governments;

Whereas, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, the Town of Hudson/Fremont County, fully participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, the Wyoming Office of Homeland Security and the Federal Emergency Management Agency Region VIII officials have reviewed the “Region 5 WY Mitigation Plan”, and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body;


Whereas, the Town of Hudson/Fremont County, desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the Region 5 WY Mitigation Plan.

Whereas, adoption by the governing body for the Town of Hudson/Fremont County, demonstrates the jurisdiction’s commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals and objectives outlined in this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan.


Whereas, adoption of this legitimacies the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan.

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RESOLUTION #2018-01 Part 2

Adoption of the Fremont County/Municipal/Tribal Emergency Operations Plan

This Emergency Operations Plan has been revised from a version last dated March 31, 2016. The EOP encompasses Fremont County Government, City of Lander, City of Riverton, Town of Dubois, Town of Shoshoni, Town of Hudson, Town of Pavillion, Northern Arapahoe Tribe and the Eastern Shoshone Tribe.

WHEREAS, The Department of Homeland Security Grant Guidance Program requires all state, territorial, local and tribal governments' Emergency Operations Plans to align with the National Response Plan coordinating structures, processes and protocols; and,

WHEREAS, All natural or manmade disasters occurring in Fremont County, regardless of the location, are responded to by all required emergency first responders; and,


WHEREAS, All first responders work under the same National Response Plan guidelines, which includes all National Incident Management System protocols which must be included in all emergency operations plans; and,

WHEREAS, All Fremont County governments and emergency services can successfully work under one emergency operations plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF Fremont County, City of Lander, City of Riverton, Town of Dubois, Town of Shoshoni, Town of Hudson, Town of Pavillion, the Northern Arapahoe and Eastern Shoshone Tribes agree one emergency operations plan can be successfully used throughout Fremont County Wyoming and asks that Fremont County Emergency Management Agency oversee this plan development.
