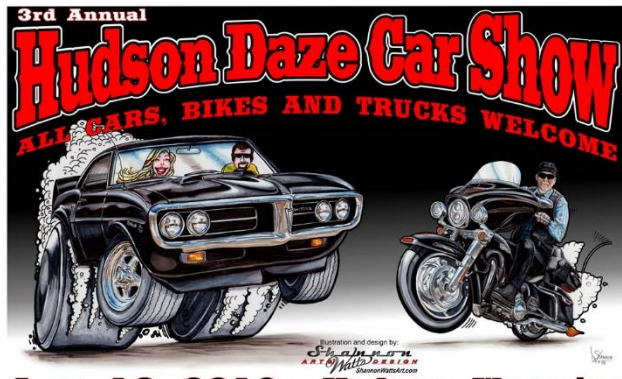
TOWN COUNCIL MEETING: The next meeting will be Tuesday, April 10th at 6p.m.

SATURDAY May 5th, ANNUAL ANIMAL LICENSING/VACCINATION CLINIC: The clinic will be held on **Saturday, May 5th from 9:00 to 11a.m.** at the **Hudson Town Hall**. As per Ordinance #811, Section 4-15 **all dogs and cats** must be registered on a yearly basis. License tags for non-neutered animals are \$7.00/year and \$5.00/year for neutered animals. **To license your animal, a proof of current rabies certificate is required.** *Dr. Richard Boulette of Wind River Veterinary Clinic is kind*
