If you are not able to get a key, please be sure to secure your debris until you can go to the pile.*

**Town, Flushing of Fire Hydrants will take place this month.** Please watch for posting at the Post Office and on the Town Hall front window. The flushing will start at 8:00a.m. and continue throughout the day. After flushing, your water may be red and dirty for a time. In order to clear your water, let your cold-water tap run for several minutes until clear water is restored. You may want to prepare to have water on hand prior to the flushing.



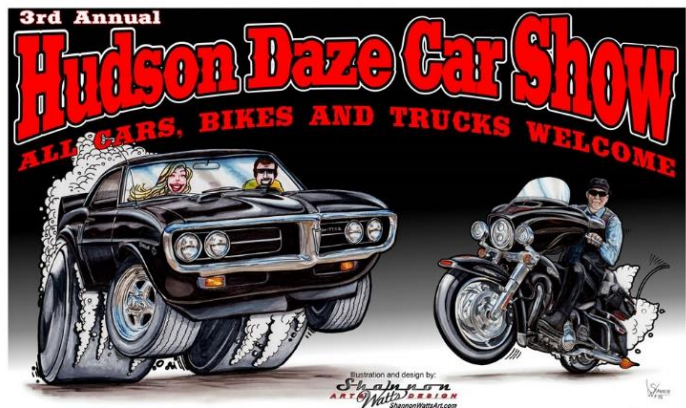

**LICENSING/VACCINATION CLINIC:** The clinic will be held on **Saturday, May 5<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 to 11a.m. at the Hudson Town Hall.** As per Ordinance #811, Section 4-15 **all dogs and cats** must be registered on a

yearly basis. License tags for non-neutered animals are \$7.00/year and \$5.00/year for neutered animals. **To license your animal, a proof of current rabies certificate is required.** *Dr. Richard*

**PREPARING FOR MOSQUITO SEASON:** A reminder to look at anything that you own outside, that can hold water. To reduce mosquito risks around your home: Look for standing water in and around your backyard. Drain or treat standing water. Use an aerosol or propane fogger to clear mosquito's. Treat shady areas around the house, especially around entry ways where resting mosquitoes are more likely to come indoors.
