Water/Sewer Accounts: The Town has online bill pay, which is free to use. Go online and sign up for AUTO PAY www.hudsonwyoming.org or www.xpressbillpay.com or call in with your credit card information. You may also drop your payment in the slot at the front door of the Hall if the office is not open.

METER READ PAD AND/OR METER PIT's: Please make sure the pathway is clear to your meter. Meters are read as close to the 20th, as possible each month. **Please make sure your dogs that may startle, and aggress are kept inside, or in a location away from the path to your meter.** Also, please continue to check your meter each month, and confirm that the pathway and area around your meter is free from ice, snow, high weeds, and/or materials being piled on, or around them. ANIMALS: Please note, any animal that is perpetually out, will be reported. There is an ordinance that prohibits animals running at

large, tending to attack, menace or bite, being a nuisance, being noisy, or being off the premises of its owner. All animals should have an application with the town to be permitted in town. For more information, please go to the town website, www.hudsonwyoming.org and look at Ordinance #825 (811) in Ordinance's and Resolution's. Also, go to forms and review the form on having no more than 3 dogs, or if you have more, you need to file for an Annual Kennel License. **Last but not least, control your pets.**
