



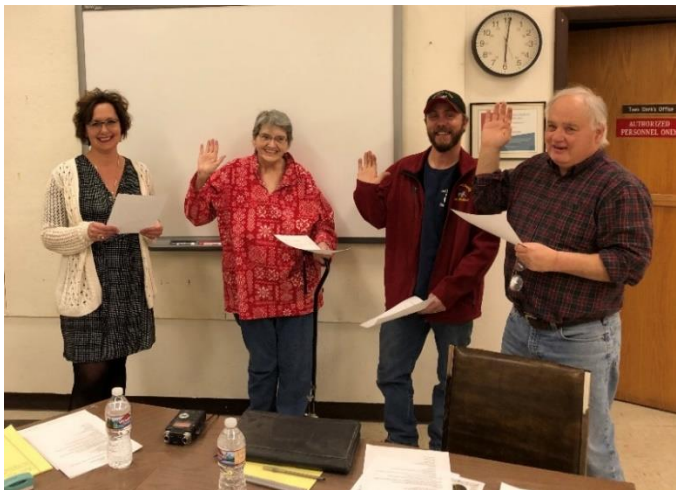



Closet: Items are free of charge. As a community, please be sure to assist in the upkeep of the closet and lend a hand to pick-up hangers or clothing that you find on the ground. We encourage everyone to enjoy what we have on hand, as the Closet also serves as a means of exchange to assist each other. Our goal is for "peace of mind", and a sense of community. **To DONATE:** Please make sure the bags, items are marked with your name and phone number. Remember, items need to be free from stain/rips, in working condition, and small, containing all their pieces and parts. For more



information please inquire at the Hall office, 332-3605. **Library Notes:** Mary Anne Robeson volunteers for the town library, and works hard to bring in a variety of books, movies, etc. She generally has the Library open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 2p.m. to 5:30p. Thank you Mary Anne for volunteering. Note: If you are not able to get out, and would like some movies or books, please call 332-5770, and leave a message with your return number. **A few Town Ordinances for review, or if your new to Town:** The town does ask that you consider your fellow neighbors. Please remember there is a noise and disturbing the peace ordinance. Do not permit your dog to bark continually or roam free around town. Additionally, please do not disturb the peace of others, by continually running snowmobiles or other recreational vehicles in town. In May, the Town offers an annual animal licensing/vaccination clinic at the Town Hall. As per Ordinance #811 – Section 4-15 **all dogs and cats** must be registered on a yearly basis. License tags for non-neutered animals are \$7.00/year and \$5.00/year for neutered animals. **To license your animal, a proof of current rabies certificate is required.** **KENNEL PERMITS:** If you own more than 3 dogs, you are required to apply for a kennel permit on a yearly basis, with May being the start date of the annual year. The cost of the permit is \$50.00 yearly. **LIVESTOCK PERMITS:** A livestock permit is required annually for all livestock be it chickens, ducks, geese, rabbits, horses, cows, llamas, donkeys, pigs, etc. A permit form may be obtained at the Hudson Town Hall at 333 South Main or you can go online to Forms at www.hudsonwyoming.org. If mailing your application to the Hall, please include payment and use P.O. Box 56 Hudson, WY 82515. Thank you! **METER READ PAD AND/OR METER PIT along with WINTER WATER ALLOWANCE of 3,000 additional GALLONS:** Please be aware that pipes are freezing due to cold weather. Be sure you turn on a trickle of cold water, and keep it running to prevent your lines from freezing. An allowance of an additional 3,000 gallons on your water bill is now permitted, for a total usage of 12,000. Please continue to check your meter and confirm that it is safe to access for our reader. With the cold weather, please make sure the area is free from ice, snow, or materials. A friendly reminder, when you signed your contract with the town, you agreed to permit **Access to Meter:** *The Town of Hudson shall always have the right to inspect and read the meter. In the event the meter is unable to be read due to such things as locked gates, unrestrained animals, or the meter being covered by snow or weeds, the customer will be assessed an additional (\$40.00) charge to their water service bill for every month the meter is unable to be read.* “The Town shall have the right to inspect the water meter and water meter pit areas at all times.” **15.40 Access to Meter and Meter Pit** “The owner of the premises and holder of the permit shall be responsible for all costs of installation for water service lines from the Town main to the structure to be served. Additionally, the owner or permit holder shall be responsible for any damage to the water meter. The water connection and lines up to the main shall belong to the owner of the premises and the owner shall be responsible for all costs of repair and replacement of any service line up to the main.” **15.43 Ownership and Responsibility for Installation, Repair and Maintenance** “The owner of the premises shall be responsible for any damage to the meter, but the meter shall remain the property of the Town. **15.47 Ownership of Meter. Also, all meters are always to be connected. It is a violation to use town water and not have your meter connected. Please be reminded that tampering with meters is prohibited. No person(s) shall tamper with any meter or alter any connection so that the meter does not accurately measure the water drawn from the municipal system. In the event the Town of Hudson finds that any meter has been tampered with, the property owner will be assessed a charge for the replacement and/or repair of the meter.**
