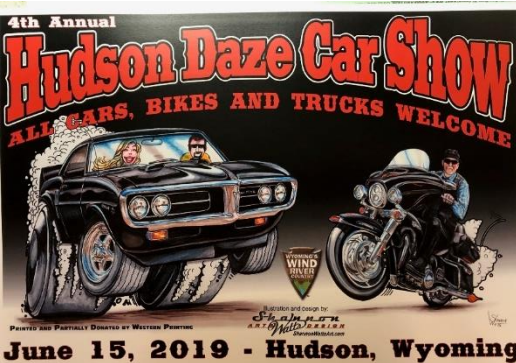

**Avenue this Fall** **WY DOT will begin the HUDSON – RIVERTON project soon.** Paving will begin at the northern limits of Hudson and extend north along the existing highway route. The project will add two eleven feet passing lanes, a 1” hot plant mix leveling course, 2” hot plant mix overlay, followed by chip sealing for approximately seven miles.

Please drop in and see me. As per Ordinance #811, Section 4-15 **all dogs and cats** must be registered on a yearly basis. License tags for non-neutered animals are \$7.00/year and \$5.00/year for neutered animals. **If your animal wanders off and no tag is on them. You will need to purchase a license and tag for them or present the issuance proof and tag previously purchased before you leave with them.**

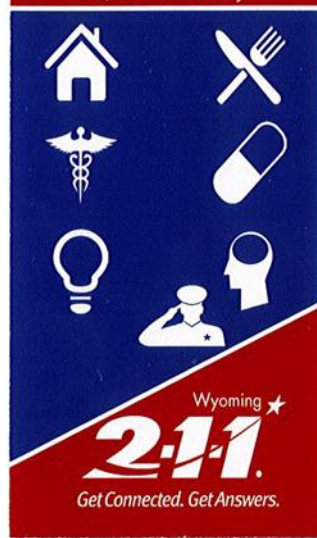
- o Wyoming Services for Independent Living - WSIL - has created an inclusive website to help residents of all ages find much needed Social Services/Resources in Western Wyoming.
